## ACRYLIC TEMPLATES USED

Fabric Requirements: We used Maywood Roses in dark blue and light blue, and scraps of yellow, green and white print. (Fabric yardage is given for the whole quilt.)

| Light Blue | Color 1 | $2-1 / 4$ yards |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Yellow | Color 2 | 1 yard |
| Green | Color 3 | 1 yard |
| Dark Blue | Color 4 | 1 yard |
| White Print | Color 5 | $1-1 / 2$ yard |

## GENERAL DIRECTIONS

All seams are $1 / 4$ throughout.
Press seams toward darker fabric after each step
Use either the full size templates to cut out the patches, or the rotary cutting instructions.
Use the template diagrams for piecing each of the blocks together
Follow finished block diagrams for color placement of patches.

## TEMPLATES:

Trace your templates on to poster board or template plastic before cutting, or use the optional acrylic templates that are available on our website. Be sure to mark the Block letter and the Template letter on each Template.

## Template Cutting Directions:

Finished size is 12 inches. You need 1 block. Cut the following number of patches:

| A | Color 5 | 4 \& 4 reversed |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| B | Color 1 | 2 |
| B | Color 4 | 2 |
| C | Color 2 | 2 |
| C | Color 3 | 2 |

## Rotary Cutting Directions:

A - Cut 2 rectangles $3-5 / 8 \times 7-1 / 4$ inches from color 5 . Cut in half diagonally making 4 half rectangles. Repeat once cutting diagonally on the opposite corners to make the reversed pieces.
B - Cut 1 square 3-7/8 inches from color 1 and color 4 . Cut in half diagonally making 2 half-square triangles of each color.
C - Cut 2 rectangles $7-3 / 8 \times 4-7 / 8$ inches from color 2 and color 3 . Cut both sides at 72 degrees from top to bottom making 2 elongated triangles of each color.

## Sewing Directions:

Step 1: Sew A and Ar half rectangles to C elongated triangle. Make 2 units with yellow and 2 units with green triangles (fig 1). Sew B light blue and dark blue triangles to units. Make 2 units of each color (fig 2).


Step 2: Layout units for block pattern (fig 3).


Step 3: Sew units together making 2 strips (fig 4). Sew strips together to complete block.
